



INPUTS & ECONOMIC IMPACTS in WNC



The presence of MAHEC in Western North Carolina is an anchor and economic engine, and brings more benefits than are captured in the impact analysis, both social and quantifiable. The scope of the analysis estimated quantifiable economic impacts of compensation and applicable operational expenditures in the 16-county region in one year, 2019. Non-resident students and visitors were not part of the analysis and construction was not stipulated. Impacts and contribution by MAHEC in the region were significant and sustain the regional economy in important ways that benefit communities. In summary, the economic impact estimated 1,000 workers that were paid \$60M labor income as part of MAHEC's \$68M impact on the Gross Regional Product of WNC. Total output, demonstrating overall economic impact, was \$94M in 2019. \$4M in tax revenues were estimated.
