







## GDP (in current dollars)













#### Change in Total Nonfarm Employment




#### Asheville Metro Total Nonfarm Employment




#### Asheville Metro - April 2019 Industry Employment




#### Asheville Metro - April 2020 Industry Employment




#### Asheville Metro - Aug 2021 Industry Employment
