







Median Age by Metro


Asheville Metro Age Composition (% of population)






Asheville Metro Total Nonfarm Employment




2021 Employment Distribution by Major Industry








Average Hourly Wages % Change by Metro

Asheville Metro Home Price and Supply




% Worked from Home by Metro




