

#### 2019-2022 Population Change %





# Asheville Metro In-Migration: Top 10 States Where People are Moving From












### Employment Change by Major Industry


2018-2023 Asheville Metro Employment Change

#### 2023 Average Unemployment Rate




## Income (Wages) and Housing




